

Dear Parents,

The Miami Dade County Youth Fair will begin on March 15 and continue until April 8. The Fair is located at Tamiami Park at 10901 Coral Way (SW 24 Street)

Your child's class has created projects that will be on display in the Arnold Hall during the entire Fair. Each student will receive a free 2 day pass that may be used any day and a free Student Admission that may be used Mon-Fri. Students 5 and under do not need a pass—they go free. Their passes may be used by any family member who accompanies them.

This year there will be a \$10.00 daily charge for parking at the Fair. You can purchase a daily pass for \$5.00 online if you visit fairexpo.com before March 14. You pay, print and present the pass when you arrive at the Fair.
